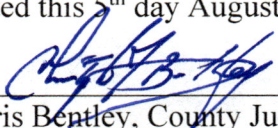

3. **CONSENT AGENDA:** The following agenda items are of a routine nature and the Commissioners Court has received supporting materials for consideration. All of these agenda items will be passed with one vote without being discussed separately, unless a member of the Commissioners Court or the public requests that a particular agenda item be discussed. If so, that agenda item will be pulled from the Consent Agenda and discussed as part of the regular agenda at the appropriate time. One vote will approve the remaining items on the Consent Agenda.

4. Discuss and possibly take action to approve various FY 2026 departmental line-item budget transfers pursuant to LGC 111.010(d).
5. Discuss and possibly take action concerning enacting a burn ban for Nacogdoches County.
6. Discuss and possibly take action to approve revisions recommended by the Parks Board to the Lake Naconiche Rules and Regulations.
