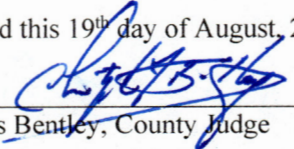
EXECUTIVE SESSION — REAL PROPERTY / CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEY
