3. **CONSENT AGENDA:** The following agenda items are of a routine nature and the Commissioners Court has received supporting materials for consideration. All of these agenda items will be passed with one vote without being discussed separately, unless a member of the Commissioners Court or the public requests that a particular agenda item be discussed. If so, that agenda item will be pulled from the Consent Agenda and discussed as part of the regular agenda at the appropriate time. One vote will approve the remaining items on the Consent Agenda.

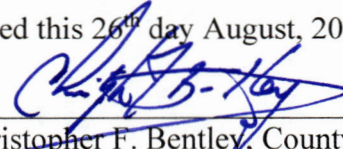
EXECUTIVE SESSION — CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEY; REAL PROPERTY

To convene a closed meeting pursuant to Texas Government Code Sections 551.071 and 551.072 to consult with legal counsel for the County regarding: 1) potential or contemplated litigation or on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with Section 551.071 and 2) to discuss the purchase, sale, exchange, lease, use, or other disposition of real property because deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the ability of the County to negotiate with a third party.
