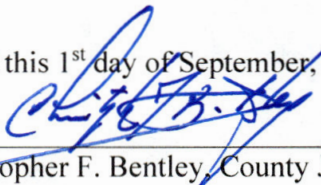
EXECUTIVE SESSION — CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEY; REAL PROPERTY
